

## National Court of Justice Practice Direction No 4 of 2020

## **Juvenile Justice Track**

## This Practice Direction is issued in consultation with and authorised by the Chief Justice.

- 1. The Judges as of June 2019 agreed to fully support the implementation of the *Juvenile Justice Act, 2014*.
- 2. A Juvenile Justice Track is now established in the National Court Criminal Registry for the expressed purpose of maintaining a record of any criminal case filed against a juvenile.
- 3. For the purposes of this rule, a juvenile is a person between the ages of 10 to 18 years.
- Where the Registry becomes aware that a case filed involves a child under the age of 10, this information should immediately be brought to the attention of the Judge Administrator for Crimes.
- 5. All files created by the Registry as a Juvenile Justice file must be kept under a separate list and must not refer to a juvenile by his or her full name, but by their initials only.
- 6. All cases involving Juveniles registered in the National Court shall have the following code;

7. A Juvenile Justice Track-list shall now be created for all registries both in Waigani and in the provincial registries.
